




## Foreword

- The Scheduling & Dispatch process is the means by which the TSOs manage the close to real-time planning and the realtime operation of units on the power system.
- This is a continuous, '24/7' process coordinated by SONI and EirGrid from the respective control centres in Belfast and Dublin using common operational systems and processes.





## Overview
